Birtcher Development Raises the Walls of Fairview's Newest Industrial Complex

WHEN: Monday, August 25 (and possibly Tuesday, August 26)

VISUALS: A crane and construction crew of 15 to 20 people maneuvering 8-foot thick, 25-foot wide, 35-foot tall concrete walls into place during construction of Fairview's largest industrial complex.

WHAT: Fairview's newest industrial complex takes shape this week as construction crews begin tilting-up the walls of the three light industrial and distribution buildings that are being built on 20.5 acres.

As many as 70 huge concrete pieces will be lifted into the air and maneuvered into place to form the walls of the buildings.

Known as Birtcher Center at Townsend Way, the 400,000-square-foot complex will house three buildings and is expected to bring 100 new jobs to Fairview.
